NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY

The Bismarck Figure Skating Club is a fully affiliated member of U.S. Figure Skating, the national governing body for the sport of figure skating in the United States. As such, the Bismarck Figure Skating Club and its members are governed by U.S. Figure Skating's nondiscrimination policies and guidelines as defined in the Official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook, Article II – Objectives, Section H; and Article XXI – Prerequisites to Participation in U.S. Figure Skating Activities, Section B.

Failure to abide by the Nondiscrimination Policy is subject to disciplinary action by the Bismarck Figure Skating Club's Board of Directors in compliance with the club Bylaws, Article III – Membership, Section 3.11 Discipline.
